

# Inquest into the deaths arising from the Lindt Café siege

## Non publication orders made by the State Coroner

1. Until further order, pursuant to s.74(1)(b) of the *Coroners Act 2009* (NSW), and as to any evidence in this inquest:
  - (a) there be no publication of anything that would tend to identify the client of Mr Ken Madden of Walter Madden Jenkins, an officer of the Tactical Operations Unit of the New South Wales Police Force, including photographs, drawings, or other likenesses; and
  - (b) the individual referred to in (1)(a) be referred to as 'Officer A', including within the coronial brief of evidence and any other documents that are served on, or made available to, the parties in this inquest.
  
2. Until further order, pursuant to s.74(1)(b) of the *Coroners Act 2009* (NSW), and as to any evidence in this inquest:
  - (a) there be no publication of anything that would tend to identify the client of Mr Greg Willis, an officer of the Tactical Operations Unit of the New South Wales Police Force, including photographs, drawings, or other likenesses; and
  - (b) the individual referred to in (2)(a) be referred to as 'Officer B', including within the coronial brief of evidence and any other documents that are served on, or made available to, the parties in this inquest.
