

# Inquest into the deaths arising from the Lindt Café siege

## Non publication and access restriction orders made by the State Coroner on 17 June 2016

Until further order, pursuant to s. 74(1)(b) of the *Coroners Act 2009* (NSW):

1. There be no publication of the following documents:

Until further order, pursuant to s. 65(4) of the *Coroners Act 2009*:

2. Subject to Order 3, the documents listed in Order 1 (“**the policy documents**”) not be supplied to any person.
3. Each legal representative for a party granted leave to appear in this inquest may be provided with one copy of each of the policy documents watermarked to identify the recipient, conditional upon an undertaking being given to the Court:
  - a. to use the policy documents and the information contained in them only for the purposes of this inquest;
  - b. to store the policy documents securely;
  - c. not to copy (physically, electronically or otherwise) the policy documents;
  - d. not to remove the documents from New South Wales;
  - e. not to give (permanently or temporarily) the policy documents to any other person;
  - f. not to disclose the policy documents or the information contained in them to any person other than a legal representative for a party granted leave to appear at this inquest who has received a copy of the policy documents pursuant to these Orders or any relevant person identified in Schedule A to these Orders who has given an undertaking to the Court:
    - i. to use the policy documents and the information contained in them only for the purposes of this inquest;
    - ii. to store the policy documents securely;
    - iii. not to copy (physically, electronically or otherwise) the policy documents;
    - iv. not to make any record of the information contained in the policy documents;

- v. not to remove the documents from New South Wales;
  - vi. not to give (permanently or temporarily) the policy documents to any other person; and
  - vii. not to disclose the policy documents or the information contained in them to any other person; and
- g. to treat any record of the information contained in a policy document as a policy document subject to this undertaking.
